Mason Lake Recreation Area Rules and Regulations

Welcome to the Mason Lake Recreation Area. Green Diamond Resource Company operates this area for the enjoyment of Green Diamond and Qualified Members. We hope you have a safe and enjoyable stay.

General Information

1. Members can only book **2** campsites per visit. *(unless permission has been granted by park rangers)*
2. Arrival time is 3pm and departure time is 1pm. Quiet time begins at 11:00 p.m. Day use area and playground close at dusk.
3. Motorcycles and ORVs. Must be unloaded outside of park property. *As of 1/2022*
4. Campsites must be paid for at the recreation office or online by arrival or upon arrival.
5. Picnic activities and other day use activities are restricted to picnic areas only.
6. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Violators are subject to immediate removal from the recreation area.
7. Authorized family members ages 18 to 22 are limited to 4 guests when camping.
8. Family members 22 and older not living at home must purchase a membership to access the park.
9. **The park is open May 1st through September 30th.**

Note: ALL FEES are subject to applicable taxes

Reservation and Cancellation Policy

1. Reservations for the main campground, group camps, kitchen and picnic shelters are available **March 1st, YEARLY** online masonlakecamp.com
2. Cancelled reservations for individual camp sites from May – September 30 will be handled as follows:
 - a. More than 4 weeks from date of arrival, 100% refund, less \$10 administration fee
 - b. 2-4 weeks from date of arrival, 50% refund
 - c. Less than 2 weeks from arrival, no refund.
3. **Group camps and kitchen rentals are non-refundable**
4. Credit card payments excepted only. **no cash or checks**

Entry

Entry to the recreation area is by an annual membership fee of **\$200.00**. *Active Green Diamond employees will be exempt. Only one card will be issued per member. **Membership fees are non-refundable (your member number is on back of your key card)***. Access cards are available by filling out a Membership Request Form (available online).

1. The entrance gate is always accessible with your key card -- the exit gate is always open.
2. **Keep your Keycard it is reactivated when yearly membership is paid.**
3. Large camping groups can ask for digital code to Access Park.
4. To open the gate, place your keycard on the stainless-steel touch plate, with the arrow pointing up.
5. Only the cardholder, a spouse, and unmarried children ages 18 to 22 who reside at home are authorized to use the key card.
6. Family members 22 and older not living at home must purchase a membership to access the park.
7. Guests are allowed overnight at the recreation area **only** while accompanied by cardholders. Cardholders are responsible for the conduct of themselves and their guests.
8. Report lost or stolen key cards immediately to the Camp office at (360) 426-0737. Lost cards can be replaced for a cost of \$30.00.
9. Misuse of your card, disorderly conduct, or refusal to comply with camp rules by cardholder or guests can result in a permanent **loss of membership privileges. For cause, membership privileges will be revoked with no refund.** Examples of misuse include loaning your card or allowing a minor to be at the recreation area unaccompanied by an adult.

General Safety

1. Report all injuries and emergencies to the on-site Ranger or staff immediately.
2. Bike riders are strongly recommended to wear helmets.

3. Campfires permitted in designated fire rings **only** -- Never leave fires unattended. Green Diamond reserves the right to prohibit open flame during fire season.
4. There is no lifeguard on duty at the swim area. An adult must supervise children in swim area at all times, no diving off docks.
5. The small boat kept at the swimming area is for emergency use **only**.
6. Children are not allowed in day use or playground area after dark. No swimming or bike riding after dark.
7. Young children must be always attended.

The Following Are Prohibited

1. The possession of explosives, fireworks, firearms, or other weapons in the MLRA.
2. The possession of illegal drugs or banned substances in the MLRA.
3. Underage alcohol consumption is prohibited in the MLRA.
4. Aggressive behavior or disorderly conduct is prohibited in the MLRA.
5. The unauthorized cutting trees or shrubbery or gathering firewood is prohibited in the MLRA.

Vehicle Use

1. Vehicles (except RVs), including motorcycles, must be parked in designated parking areas only.
2. Only two vehicles at each campsite unless permission by staff has been given, \$5/night extra vehicle fee for 3rd +.
3. Speed limit is 5 mph. Use extreme caution when driving through the recreation area and watch for children always.
4. Vehicles are subject to tow if blocking main entrance, back gate, or any unauthorized spot.
5. Vehicles are not allowed to drive into day-use areas.
6. Campground runs one direction, please follow arrows.

Boat and Watercraft Use

1. Boat launch requires a **\$5** launch fee (registered campers excluded. must present camping receipt in window.
2. Boats will be operated in accordance with Mason County Motorboat Ordinance; posted at boat ramp.
3. Boat docks are reserved on a first come first serve basis through the recreation office and are only available for those camping.
4. No wake zone within 100 feet of the shoreline.
5. All watercrafts must launch and continue counterclockwise.
6. Boats towing skiers must have at least two persons in the boat - one operator and one observer.
7. Watercraft, ski and tube users must wear life jackets.
8. Jet skis and wave runners may be launched at boat ramp and moored at any of the boat docks.
9. Boat and jet- ski trailers must be parked in designated parking areas, not campsites.
- 10. No over-the-transom exhaust boats (no muffler)**
11. Watercrafts are not allowed inside the buoyed swim area
12. No fueling watercraft in Mason Lake
13. No boating activity after 11PM.
14. Tying boats to YOUR OWN buoys is allowed.

15. Beaching boats or jet-skis on shoreline is NOT allowed.

Off Road vehicle rules

1. Only John Eaton's Shelton Dirt Rider members are allowed to ride on trails outside of recreation area.
2. Motorcycles and quads are **not** allowed to drive around the park, they must be loaded and unloaded of park property.
3. Electric bikes and scooters must follow all road rules posted in park.
4. Very Loud bikes we ask you to push them out to the parking lots before starting them.

Pet Rules

1. Dogs must be on a leash and always attended.
2. "Poop and Scoop" pet stations are located around the recreation area for your convenience.
3. Aggressive or threatening dogs are prohibited.
4. Pets are not allowed in the lake within the buoyed swim area.
5. Park Rangers are authorized to direct campers to remove a problem dog at any time.

Quiet Hours

1. Quiet Time is from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
2. Minor children must be at their campsite during Quiet Time unless accompanied by their parents.
3. Visitors must leave by 10:00 p.m.
4. No loud music at any time. TV's and radios must not be heard beyond your campsite, and those outside must be turned off during Quiet Time.
5. Please keep voices down during Quiet Time your voices shouldn't be heard beyond your campsite.
6. Turn off **your** outdoor lights when retiring for the evening.
7. Profanity will not be tolerated at any time.
8. Loud and obnoxious individuals will not be tolerated and may be asked to leave without a refund.
9. Local law enforcement will be contacted if necessary.
10. Eviction from the park will result in loss of park privileges for up to 2 years or indefinitely.
11. Campers who have to be asked to quiet down on multiple times throughout the year will receive a mark on their membership, 3 marks in one year will result in loss of park privileges. Please be considerate of others.
12. Green Diamond Resource Company is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Be sure to lock and secure all vehicles.

Enforcement

Members are responsible for their guest's behavior, if guests are asked to leave due to violation of park rules both member and guest will be asked to leave the property, and member will receive a certified letter stating actions that will be taken against the member.

Members of the recreation area will have 2 strikes you're out policy, Park staff will notify member of any violations
